

If the final cost exceeds the estimated cost, an additional fee may be required before the issuance of the Certificate of Occupancy. 4. An electrical certificate must be obtained from a city approved electrical inspector for all electrical work. 5. Building permits expire (3) years from the date of issuance and must be renewed if work is not complete. 6. This document is not a building permit. It is only an application for a building permit.

Stamped Plans Required: You may be required to submit plans that have been reviewed and stamped by a New York State licensed Engineer or Architect. The following situations will require stamped plans. 1. The removal or cutting away of any load bearing wall, partition, or portion thereof, or of any structural beam or load bearing component. 2. The removal of or change of any required means of egress, or the rearrangement of parts of a structure in a manner which affects egress. (This includes the addition of an exterior fire escape) 3. New residential structures

- **Ledger boards must be attached to building with fasteners installed by staggered spacing and resistant to withdrawal. Toe nailing is not an acceptable means of securing the ledger board. Securing ledger boards to masonry components of the structure require the use of epoxy adhesives.
- **All beams must bear on a minimum of 1 ½ inches of supporting material.
- **If using Sonotubes or Quik-tubes minimum of 12" diameter required.

Current State Code Requirements (stairs and decks)

•1 & 2 Family

- Riser Height 8 1/4 "max.
- Tread Depth 9" min.
- Tread Nosing min. 34 and not more than 1 1/4
- Stairway Width min. 36"
- Baluster spacing no more than 4" apart
- Landings 36" X 36"
- Handrail Height 34"- 38"
- Footer Depth 48"
- Min. footer width 12"

Commercial & Multi- Family

- Min. stair width 36", over 50 people 44"
- Riser Height 4"min. 7"max.
- Tread Depth 11"min.
- Landings size must be at least width of stairway they serve in direction of travel and need not exceed 48"
- Handrail height 34" to 38"
- Guard rails required on surfaces 30" above grade
- Footer Depth 48"

Additional Requirements for Porches

- Rafter size and spacing
- Decking Material for Roof
- Type of roofing
- Schedule of doors and windows

• Insulation (if enclosed)

Current State Code Requirements (Ramps)

Residential

- Max. Slope 1unit vertical in 12 units horizontal *
 Landings shall be 3'x 3'
- Handrails may be required

*exception my apply

Commercial

- Max. Slope 1 unit vertical in 12 units horizontal*
- Max. 30" total rise
- Min. width 36"
- Min. landing 5' x 5'
- Slip resistant surface
- Rise of >6" requires handrail on at least one side
