Directions to Oneonta Area Mountain Biking Trailhead Parking & Kiosks

(All routes starting from I 88 Exits)

Oneonta Susquehanna Greenway at Silas Lane – Exit I88 at exit #17 and turn south at the end of the ramp. Silas Lane will be on the right before crossing over the Susquehanna River. There are two kiosks and parking areas for the trail. The first parking area and kiosk is on the right side just after the City garage and accesses the trail as it travels parallel to I 88. The second Parking area and kiosk is at the end of the road. Turn left towards the soccer fields and you will see the kiosk and trailhead in the left corner of the parking area. Follow the edge of the field to the main trail as it travels parallel to the Susquehanna River.

<u>Oneonta Susquehanna Greenway at Catella Park/New Island</u> - Exit I 88 at exit #15 and head north towards the City of Oneonta. At the traffic light junction with Main St (Rt. 7) turn left and then make the immediate next left on Grand St. Bear right (by Grummons Funeral Home) onto Divison St which becomes Prospect St. Take the second left onto James Georgeson Ave, over the railroad tracks and into Nehwaha Park. Take the first left onto David Brenner Dr which parallels the millrace and goes under Lettis Hwy into Catella Park. The parking area and trailhead kiosk will be on the right.

<u>Wilber Park Trails</u> – Exit I 88 at exit #15 and head north towards the City of Oneonta. At the intersection light with Main St (Rt. 7) go straight onto Maple St. At the next light (intersection with Center St.) turn right and travel 3 blocks (up the hill) to the entrance to Wilber Park on your left through the large metal gate. The parking area and trailhead kiosk will be on your right opposite the playground area.

<u>SUNY Oneonta College Camp Trails</u> – Exit I 88 at exit #15 and head north towards the City of Oneonta. At the intersection light with Main St (Rt. 7) go straight onto Maple St. At the next light (intersection with Center St.) turn right and at the next corner turn left onto East St. Travel up East St. about half a mile to a left turn onto Bugbee Rd. (follow signs for SUNY Oneonta). Take the second right off Bugbee onto Blodgett Dr and the parking area and trailhead kiosk are on your left at the top of the hill above the softball field (labeled Softball Parking). If the softball field parking is full there is additional parking available just a little further up the service road above the intramural softball field.

<u>Homer Folks State Forest Trails</u> – Exit I 88 at exit #15 and head north towards the City of Oneonta. At the intersection light with Main St. (Rt.7) go straight onto Maple St. At the next light (intersection with Center St.) turn left and follow Center St. until it ends and turn right onto West St. Travell up West St about a mile (past the entrance for SUNY Oneonta) to the entrance for Job Corps and Homer Folks Facility on your left. Take Homer Folks Ave to the top and turn left on Hill St. The parking area will be on the left at the top of Hill St. by the buildings and trailhead kiosk will be on the right.
